U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Rock Island District

Reminder - three locks will be closed on the Illinois Waterway for significant maintenance that is long overdue.

The locks at

Brandon Road Dresden Island Marseilles

will be closed June 1 - September 30, 2023.

While the locks will be closed, navigation on the rest of the river, between the locks, will not be impacted.

<u>Please note</u> - Starved Rock Lock and Dam was previously on the 2023 closure list but has been removed and will no longer close in 2023.

Boating Safety

FREE Boater Safety Classes are again being offered at the Starved Rock Lock Illinois Waterway Visitor Center.

Classes for the 2023 season will be held on <u>April 15, May 20, June 17, July 15, and August</u> <u>19 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m</u>.

The class is recommended for new boaters, families that enjoy boating adventures and seasoned boaters who would like to brush up on their safe boating knowledge.

Class covers the basics of boater safety, equipment, emergency measures, navigation, boating laws and motorboat registration and titling.

One 8-hour class is required to complete your certification. Anyone over the age of 12 can be certified. Students under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
